They're all— they're all prekindergarten contracts they're prekindergarten contracts 9 in all the first seven of them are pursuant to an open ended RFP which is actually the second of two RFPs we did that was for pre-K and the first one was the original RFP which you've already seen more contracts in front of the panel there will also be some technical changes that we'll get to you tomorrow.

As in the past they're just that, they're technical changes to information that were provided before.

Usually numbers changes or, you know, just clarifying names where-- you know, wherever that needs to be done.

But and all of that is required to get these contracts over to the controllers office for registration , so it is equally important we get these technical changes done so we can get these contracts registered and get these vendors paid as quickly as possible.

So that's it.

We have these 9 contracts in front of you for new approval.

And we'll have some additional technical changes to you tomorrow as well. So the only voting items of course typically are the-- the new contracts. Questions?

Yeah I can go back and look at the specific site in this case I can't tell you offhand.

One possibility is definitely the occupancy costs are different from site to site from one provider , that could be one driver of the cost.

It could also be that they're running slightly different programming across those sites. What was the name-->> There are variances across the-->> Yeah it's all by the same and they also asked for different startup costs and it's just-->> Yeah startup costs would certainly be related to the specific -->> Right but the per child cost like that was the one that I'm just curious I understand you got a big room a small room you need X amount of furniture, but it's the per cost of the child , you know, is that one program you're doing something special and they get to go swimming I don't know. It's something I'd be curious about. But wouldn't stop me from supporting it. >> could also be teacher salary. (inaudible) perhaps one site microphone more experienced teachers the other is expansion site and (inaudible) salary.
